

Directions to Lee's Landing

From Lynchburg, cross the James River into Madison Heights.

If taking the John Lynch Bridge (Rt.163), go to top of the hill and turn right at first light onto the Old Town Connector (Rt. 210). Former Webb's Sporting Goods is on the right hand corner.

If taking the Carter Glass Bridge (Rt.29 Expressway), take the first exit ramp north of the bridge and turn right at the light at the end of the ramp onto the Old Town Connector (Rt. 210).

In either of the above cases, proceed east on the Old Town Connector (Rt. 210) to a stoplight where Wright Shop Rd. (Rt. 622) is to your left and Colony Road (Rt. 334) is to your right. Turn right onto Colony Rd.

If taking the Monacan Bridge (Rt.29 Bypass), take the first exit ramp north of the bridge on to the Old Town Connector (Rt. 210). Proceed west on the Old Town Connector (Rt. 210) to the first stoplight where Wright Shop Rd. (Rt. 622) is to your right and Colony Road (Rt. 334) is to your left. Turn left on to Colony Rd.

Once on Colony Rd. (Rt.334), proceed to the grounds of Central Virginia Training Center. Follow the main road as it bears around to the left of the campus. Proceed through the campus to a crossroad intersection with two large overhead water storage tanks on the right hand corner.

Pass straight through that intersection and the road will change to Carolina Ave. (Rt. 1013). Proceed on Carolina Ave. about 2/10 mile to a point where Rt. 1013 continues on downhill as a gravel road (Fertilizer Rd.) and the paved road turns sharp right uphill. The paved road will still be Carolina Ave. But will probably not be marked and is a private road from that point on. An abandoned water treatment will be on your left immediately before that point.

Take Carolina Ave. about another 2/10 mile into a mobile home park. Bear right at an intersection where a row of mailboxes is located. At that point you will be on Mike's Landing but may not be marked as such.

From a right at the mailboxes, proceed straight ahead on Mike's Landing past a point where the paved road turns to gravel as you pass Overlook Drive on the right and an equipment storage area on the left. Do not turn on Overlook Dr.

On the gravel road, still Mike's Landing but probably not marked, stay straight ahead through a gate, pass some additional equipment storage areas, and continue on down the hill to the river.

As you come within sight of the river, the road turns sharply left as it passes under a railroad trestle.

And Viola! You have arrived at your destination!
